Please note the following before making out your declaration

1. If the declaration covers future donations, you are **able to cancel** the declaration at any time by notifying the church. It will not then apply to donations made after the date of cancellation or such later date as you specify.
2. Please notify the church of any **change of name or address** while the declaration is in force.
3. You must pay an **amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax** at least equal to the tax that the church reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give). Remember that you do not have to be in employment to be a tax payer.
4. There should be only **one person** making the declaration.
5. If your **circumstances change** in the future and you no longer pay tax on your income and/or capital gains equal to the tax the church reclaims, you can cancel your declaration.
6. If you are paying tax at a **higher** than standard rate, then you can reclaim the difference through your own Self Assessment tax return.
7. Because of the need to identify your gift(s), **payments must be by:**
 - a) cash or cheque, using numbered church offering envelopes.
 - b) by bankers standing order.
 - c) by cheque in the offering making clear it is a Gift Aid donation
